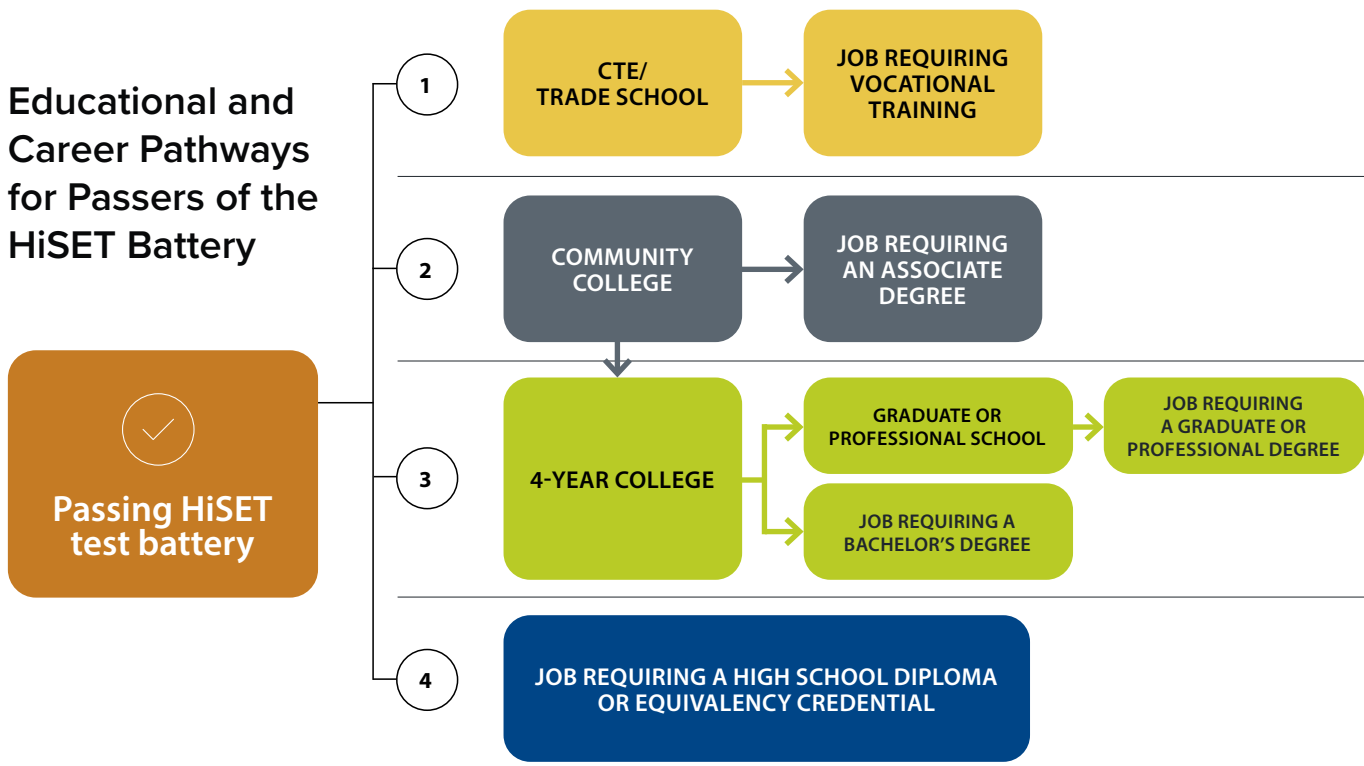
COMMITMENT TO SELF-IMPROVEMENT
